

Transit Access Pass (TAP) Los Angeles

- [TAP Vendor](#): TAP vendors sell TAP cards as well as add fare products using an RPOS device.
- [GO TAP Accounts](#): Allows groups and organizations to manage a large amount of registered TAP cards via a web site.
- [Non-profit](#): Non-profit agencies are eligible to apply a 3.75% discount on the price of each pass. Contact: palaciosm@metro.net or 213.922.2417
- [Reduced Fare](#): Metro's Reduced Fare Program enable eligible applicants to purchase fare at a reduced rate.

[Low Income Fare is Easy \(LIFE\)](#): The LIFE program offers discounts towards Metro and other agency passes.

The program offers a \$24 discount off the monthly or weekly pass for Regular Riders, an \$8 discount off the monthly senior/disabled pass, a \$10 discount off the monthly K-12 pass, and a \$14 discount for college/vocational monthly pass for most bus lines in LA County as well as the EZ transit pass. To be eligible for the program, you must be a Los Angeles county resident and fall below the following income guidelines:

Persons in household / Annual Income

1 / \$33,950 or less

2 / \$38,800 or less

3 / \$43,650 or less

4 / \$48,450 or less

5 / \$52,350 or less

6 / \$56,250 or less

You may apply for the transit coupons at one of our partner agencies on the list below. Please contact the agency most convenient for you and see when they will be open for you to come in and apply for the program, as each agency has a different schedule. We do not mail applications, you must apply in person.

When you apply, you will need your ID and proof of income (such as recent check stubs, previous years taxes, proof of public benefit, etc.), as well as IDs for anyone else in your immediate family you are applying for, and your TAP card.



Thank you for your interest in the LIFE (Low Income Fare is Easy) Transportation Program. To apply for the program, please follow the steps outlined below:

Step #1

Review the enclosed LIFE brochure to ensure that you meet the income eligibility requirements of the program

Step #2

Identify an agency in the enclosed agency listing that is most geographically convenient for you to visit.

Step #3

Call the agency of your choice, and be sure to ask about distribution days and hours, ask if an appointment is necessary, ask if they have the coupon available for your specific pass type (Regular, Disabled, Senior, Student (K-12) or College/Vocational), and lastly be sure to ask if there are any additional requirements. (Each agency is different)

Step #4

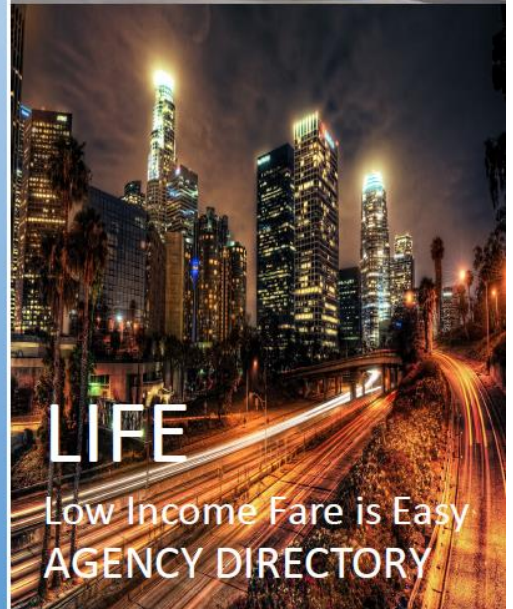
Once your appointment is scheduled, remember to take your proof of identity, and identity for any additional household members, proof of income & TAP Cards for all participants.
