Subject: COVID-19 Vaccine News & Updates

Members (CEOs, CMOs, COOs, CFOs),

Important news on COVID-19 vaccines:

- The state registry is now open for health centers to register to provide the vaccine via the [COVIDReadi](#) portal. Please register if you are planning to provide the vaccine to your staff and/or patients.
- Health center staff will be able to get vaccinated starting 12/28. LADPH will use a hub and spoke model for health center staff vaccinations – staff will either be vaccinated by their employer at their work site, or at a nearby health center or hospital location. LADPH sent an invitation email and [survey](#) about your staff and your capacity to provide vaccines. Please respond to the survey with site-specific information by COB Friday, December 18.

Timeline for Distribution

With Pfizer in distribution and Moderna on the way, here is the timeline for distribution in LA.

Week of 12/14-

- 82,875 Pfizer doses arrived in LA County
- Vaccines were shipped to 9 sites across the county and re-packaged then allocated to all 83 acute care hospitals

Week of 12/21-

- 116,300 Moderna doses (contingent on EUA) to arrive in LA County
 - Vaccines prioritized for EMS providers and skilled nursing facilities staff and residents
- 80,000 Pfizer doses
 - Vaccines prioritized for additional acute care hospital staff

Week of 12/28- Vaccine quantity unknown but doses prioritized for:

- correctional health facility staff and psychiatric hospitals
- non-skilled nursing facility long-term care facilities staff and residents
- dialysis center staff
- ambulatory care workers (includes FQHC and community clinic staff)

LADPH Engagement

CCALAC is actively engaged with the LA County Department of Public Health (LADPH) and meeting on a biweekly basis to discuss COVID-19 vaccine distribution planning. CCALAC is also participating in the LA County COVID-19 Vaccination Workgroup, which last met on December 15. The workgroup has three sub-committees; CCALAC has a representative on each committee:
