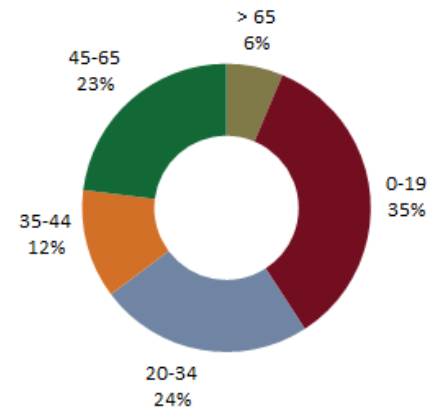

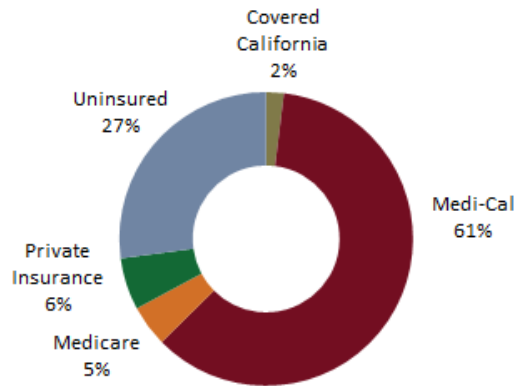

Community clinics provide care to patients that span a wide range of ages



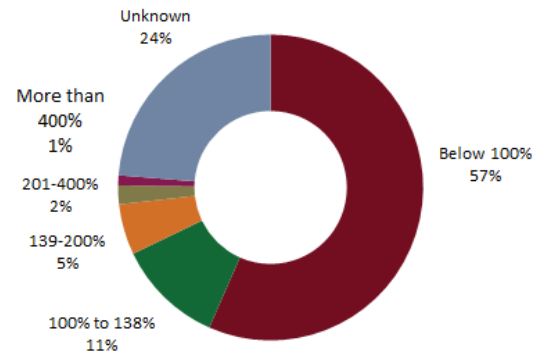
ARE THE FOUNDATION OF THE SAFETY NET
