



Upcoming Webinar Series: Emergency Housing Vouchers for Survivors

Recently, 6,863 Emergency Housing Vouchers (EHVs) have been allocated to the City and County of Los Angeles for use in assisting people experiencing homelessness or are at-risk of homelessness. These EHVs are similar to a Housing Choice Voucher / Section 8 and are open to survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking, dating violence, and human trafficking.

Application for and distribution of EHVs will be handled through the Coordinated Entry System (CES). To assist you with this process, LAHSA's Domestic Violence Systems Alignment Team will be hosting a Webinar on EHVs, as well as a series of "Deep Dives" into EHV application workflows that apply to specific populations (ie. emergency shelters, victim service providers).

This webinar will provide information to organizations and agencies regarding Emergency Housing Vouchers (EHVs). Participants will learn about EHVs, understand LAHSA's EHV Policy, eligibility and referral process, as well as LAHSA's role and the role of organizations/agencies in helping survivors access EHVs.
