### Announcements:

- DPH has not received Johnson & Johnson vaccines yet. They are waiting on information from the State about the number of vaccines to expect and when to expect them.
- DPH intends to communicate and allocate an increased amount of vaccines as they more are sent to the County.
- Over the weekend, the myCAVax system changed its website address (URL). When accessing the CalVax site, you will seamlessly be redirected to the new myCAVax URL (<https://mycavax.cdph.ca.gov/>). We recommend you bookmark the new site, as the former URL will become inactive in the coming weeks. Log in to the system with your current username and password. There is no impact to system data, records, or accounts. CDPH will communicate next steps for updating your myCAVax login credentials as they are made available. We have updated the [myCAVax Name Change FAQ Document](#) with additional details about the name and URL change.
- Tier 1B opened. Those in education, agriculture & food, and emergency management are now eligible to receive vaccinations.

- DPH has a goal to have all approved clinics in myCAVax become approved suppliers for Blue Shield.
- The transition to MyTurn continues. DPH is reaching out to clinics to begin onboarding.

### Eligibility

- Q: Clinics express challenges around the expansion of the Tiers as there it adds a lot of pressure. Who is an agricultural worker? Do gardeners and landscapers count?
  - A: Clinics are asked to refer to DPH's Playbook (attached) to see what types of workers are eligible.
  - A: Regarding food & agriculture, private gardeners and landscapers are not eligible to be vaccinated. Workers in this category must be related to food work, which even includes transportation, manufacturing, and production.
- Clinics expressed concerns of inequity around undocumented babysitters or nannies being eligible to be vaccinated as they work with children.
  - DPH will get information and clarify if babysitters and nannies are eligible.
- Q: What is the eligibility criteria or what kind of document can workers who are paid in cash or under the table bring?
  - A: Attestations can be used. Clinicians can think about what's acceptable to you as a clinic provider and if a document is legitimate as you know the population and community
