

# HRSA Direct FQHC Vaccine Program Overview

- **11M** doses to FQHCs;  
**1M** to initial cohort of 250 health centers
- Priority populations
  - Individuals experiencing homelessness
  - Public housing residents
  - Migrant/Seasonal agricultural workers
  - Patients w/ limited English proficiency
- California Participation
  - 43 FQHCs invited; 26 actively participating
  - AltaMed
  - Northeast Valley Health
  - JWCH
  - St. John's Well Child & Family Center

# Vaccine Allocation

- FQHC patients are the focus; not restricted to
- Must adhere to California's tiered vaccination system
- Moderna, Johnson & Johnson, and Pfizer available; no order caps for initial cohort
- California allocations to date
  - Week of 2/22; 18,000
  - Week of 3/1; 23,700
  - Week of 3/8; 66,280



# Challenges and Next Steps

- Challenges
  - VPoP enrollment technical glitches
  - Data reporting & platform interoperability
  - Financial resource constraints
- Future FQHC Enrollment
  - Must resolve VPoP technical glitches
  - Need time to see impact
