


User Registration Process

Creating An Account



Using Microsoft or Google Account

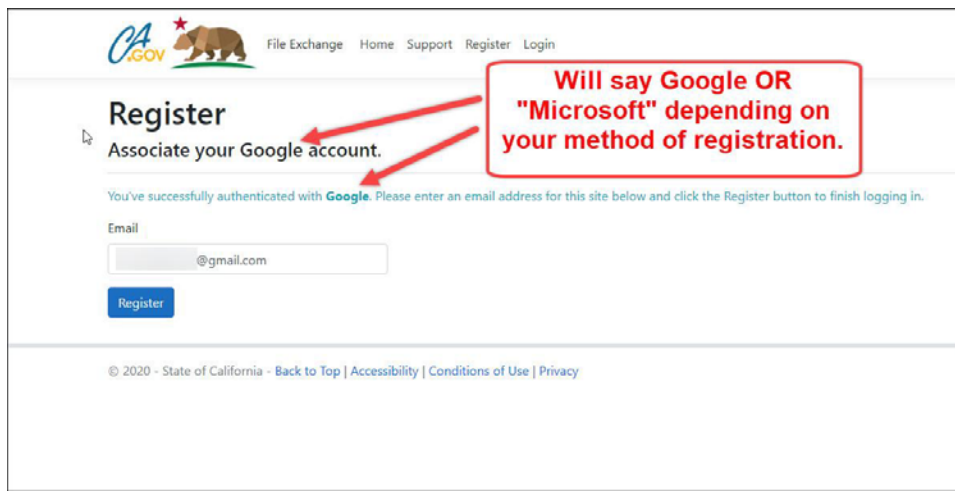
For Microsoft or Google, click the respective icon...



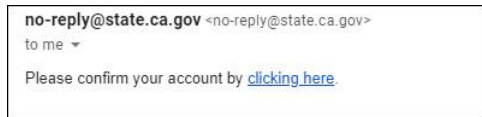
You will then see the Microsoft or Google sign in page. Log in as you normally would for other applications.



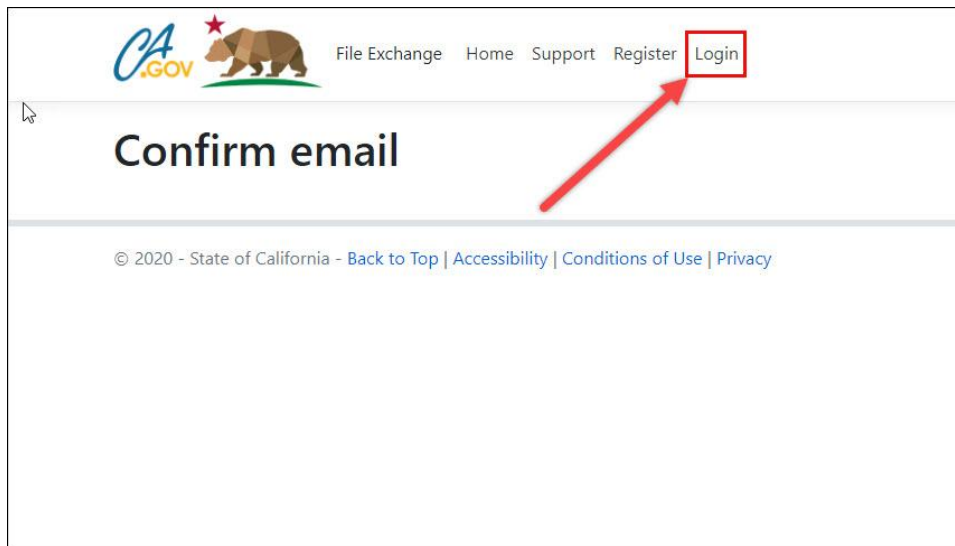
You will then need to check you're email to confirm the registration of the email address.
