Q: Does the vaccine have the virus in it?

A: No, the COVID vaccine does not contain the virus.



Q: Will the vaccine change my DNA?

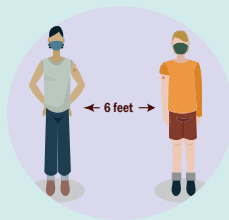
A: No - the COVID vaccine assists your body with making antibodies, which will help fight off COVID!



Q: What are the side effects of the vaccine?

A: Some people will feel arm soreness and cold/flu symptoms after getting the vaccine. Fewer than five in a million people will have a severe allergic reaction. We are still learning about longterm vaccine effects.

What Happens After I Get the Vaccine?



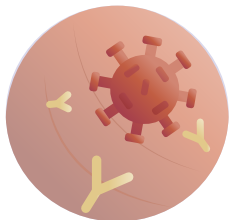
Continue to wear a mask, social distance, and get tested for COVID during the pandemic.
