## Job Description

The Center for Family Health and Education is accepting applications for full time LMFT, LCSW, MFT Associate and/or license eligible, to join our multidisciplinary team to provide comprehensive mental health and therapeutic treatment services for adults, children and adolescents/TAY ages birth to 25. Individual and family services will primarily be provided in the clinic.

### DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work with adults, children and TAY ages birth to 25 years and their families.
- Provide comprehensive biopsychosocial assessment for clients.
- Provide individual, family, and group therapy using evidence based psychotherapy interventions, and case management as needed.
- Likes collaborating and communicating with a multidisciplinary treatment team; and makes referrals as needed.
- Demonstrate empathy to work with adults, children/families under stress.
- Participate in weekly staff meeting and appropriate supervision and consultation.

### REQUIREMENTS & QUALIFICATIONS

- Two or more years of direct practice experience working with adults, children, adolescents/TAY and families.
- Clients include adults, young children and adolescents with serious and persistent mental illness; extensive trauma histories including foster care placement; and co-occurring disorders.
- Excellent assessment skills.
- Strong time management and organizational skills.
- Skilled in engaging, motivating and working with diverse individuals and groups to accomplish established goals.
- Self-directed, efficient and effective in problem solving and managing multiple demands and objectives.
- Knowledge of Los Angeles County Department of Mental Health (DMH) clinical paperwork and timelines.
- Registered, licensed-eligible MFT-Associate/Intern, LMFT, LCSW
