To provide consultation, diagnosis and treatment of related medical conditions, under supervision of Medical Director.

## QUALIFICATIONS:

### JOB QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE

1. Minimum of two (2) years clinical experience preferred;
2. Thorough knowledge of principles and practices of modern medicine related to public health services; general knowledge of state and federal laws pertaining to public health;
3. Excellent verbal and written communication skills, including strong organizational and interpersonal skills;
4. Demonstrated ability to work effectively with men and women of diverse races, ethnicities, ages, and sexual orientations in a multicultural environment;

### TRAINING, EDUCATION, AND LICENSURE

1. Current license to practice medicine within the state;
2. Board-certified or Board eligible;
3. Current BLS certification.

### RESPONSIBILITIES: GENERAL DESCRIPTION

1. Examines patient, takes medical history, records results, and makes preliminary diagnosis or decides on follow-up procedures;
2. Administers or orders diagnostic tests, blood work, and interprets test results;
3. Performs therapeutic procedures such as immunizations, injections, and managing infection;
4. Exercises professional judgment regarding consultation with medical director concerning appropriate treatment;
5. Develops and implements patient care plans, instructs and counsels patients and records progress;
6. Prescribes medications to the extent allowable by state guidelines and clinic regulations;
7. Provides health education regarding health maintenance especially in the realm of STD prevention;
8. Prescreens cases requiring review by the Medical Director;
9. Participates in staff meetings, planning meetings and other meetings as needed;
10. Participates in the program's ongoing quality assurance monitoring.
