

Position Title:

Staff Physician – Family Medicine

Summary:

Under the direct supervision of the Chief Medical Officer the physician provides comprehensive family practice medical care in a community health center.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Responsible for providing the full range of out-patient comprehensive family practice medical care to include, but not limited to medical diagnosis, medical treatment, medical follow up care, health promotion and disease prevention, medical consultation, medical referrals and urgent / emergency medical care, including medical care to pediatrics (including newborns) through senior citizens.
 2. Responsible for referring patients for hospitalization as necessary and provides or coordinates in-patient care.
 3. Responsible for providing follow-up care to out-patients and in-patients.
 4. Responsible for supervising and providing consultative service to mid-level practitioners.
 5. Responsible for providing consultative services to the nursing staff and other physicians.
 6. Responsible for precepting Medical Students, Nurse Practitioner students and Residents as assigned.
 7. Responsible for participating in the Agency's in-service training program.
 8. Responsible for rotating on-call schedule for nights, weekends and holidays.
 9. Responsible for participating in the Agency's clinical and non-clinical quality improvement activities and programs, and for meeting medical performance quality indicators.
 10. Responsible for following all Agency safety and health standards, regulations, procedures, policies, and practices.
 11. Responsible for actively participating in the Improving Organizational Performance Program, which includes but is not limited to Infection Control, Health and Safety Program, Emergency Preparedness Program, Risk Management Program and Medical Staff programmatic activities.
 12. Performs other duties as assigned.
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REQUIREMENTS:

1. Board certified or Board eligible in Family Medicine, by the American Board of Family Medicine or by the American Osteopathic Board of Family Practice/ OMT.
2. Residency completion certificate.
3. Current license to practice medicine in California.
4. Current CPR certificate.
5. Current DEA license.
6. Knowledgeable of, competent and compliant with Electronic Medical Records.
7. Knowledgeable of the Hispanic culture and good working knowledge of Spanish in order to adequately discuss diagnosis, treatment and prognosis with the patient and to handle emergency calls in Spanish.
8. Ability to provide quality, comprehensive, continuity of medical care in a compassionate manner with minimum supervision.
9. Ability to work well with others in a professional manner in a team oriented environment.
10. Valid California Driver's License, access to an automobile, and state-required auto liability coverage.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

The employee will be required to continuously sit, stand, and walk throughout the work day. Frequent bending at the waist and knees are required along with occasional reaching overhead and the pulling of objects. Continuous grasping of medical instrument and objects will be required. Occasional lifting of objects weighing 10 lbs. or less and objects weighing 26 to 50 lbs. is required. Frequent carrying of objects weighing 10 lbs. or less and occasional carrying of objects weighing 11 to 25 lbs. is required to perform the essential functions of the job.

MENTAL DEMANDS

The mental demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

The employee will be required to occasionally handle stress and emotions as well as frequent concentration on tasks, adjustment to changes, and observance of details.
