JOB DESCRIPTION

Position Title: Staff Physician – Pediatrics

Under the direct supervision of the Chief Medical Office, the Pediatrician provides pediatric medical care in a community health center.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Responsible for providing out-patient comprehensive medical care to full range pediatric age group including but not limited to medical diagnosis, medical treatment, medical follow-up care, health promotion, disease prevention, medical consultation, medical referrals, urgent and emergency medical care/stabilization, referrals for hospitalization.
2. Responsible for providing and/or coordinating in-patient care as necessary.
3. Responsible for providing follow-up out-patient and in-patient care.
4. Responsible for working directly with other physicians in the management of patient caseloads in the Agency's health centers.
5. Responsible for providing consultative services to the nursing staff and other physicians.
6. Responsible for rotating on the on-call schedule for nights, weekends, and holidays.
7. Responsible for supervising and providing consultative service to Mid-Level Practitioners.
8. Responsible for precepting Medical Students, Nurse Practitioner students and Residents as assigned.
9. Responsible for participating in the Agency's in-service training programs.
10. Responsible for participating in the Agency's clinical and non-clinical quality improvement activities and programs and for meeting medical performance quality indicators.
11. Responsible for following all Agency safety and health standards, regulations, procedures, policies, and practices.
12. Responsible for actively participating in the Improving Organizational Performance Program, which includes but is not limited to Infection Control, Health and Safety Program, Emergency Preparedness Program, Risk Management Program and Medical Staff programmatic activities.
13. Performs other duties as assigned.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Board Certified or board eligible in Pediatrics.
2. Residency completion certificate.
3. Current license to practice medicine in California.
4. Current CPR certificate.
5. Current DEA license.
6. Knowledgeable of, competent and compliant with Electronic Medical Records.
7. Knowledgeable of the Hispanic culture and good working knowledge of Spanish in order to discuss diagnosis, treatment and prognosis adequately with the patient and to handle emergency calls in Spanish.
8. Ability to provide quality, comprehensive, and continuity of medical care in a compassionate manner with minimum supervision.
9. Ability to work well with others in a professional manner in a team oriented environment.
