Primary Responsibilities:

- Assisting doctors with examinations and other nursing procedures; collecting and labeling laboratory specimens in accordance with laws and policies.
- Maintaining complete and accurate patient records.
- Data entry thru EHR.
- Administering EKG's, IV therapy, checks patient's vital signs, catheterization and irrigation.
- Strictly adhering to universal precautions as established by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention, Occupational Safety and Health Administration, DHS/OA and clinic standards.
- Assisting doctors with examinations and other procedures relating to direct patient care.
- Dressing wounds.
- Administering immunizations and medications.
