Qualifications:

1. Current certification as Lactation Consultant (IBCLC) with at least 3-5 years of experience.
2. Basic Life Support Certified – Adult, Child, Infant for the professional rescuer, sponsored by the American Heart Association required.
3. Previous experience working in a community setting and/or with low income, underserved and /or high-risk populations is desirable.
4. Maintains current Basic Life Support Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) certificate and documentation on mandatory requirements such as TB testing, medical examinations and competency standards.
5. Thorough working knowledge of business English, spelling, punctuation, and contemporary general office practices and procedures.
6. Computer skills in Microsoft Office programs (Word, Excel, etc.), electronic health record systems, and database systems.
7. Strong verbal and interpersonal skills to communicate clearly and effectively with patients and others.
8. Experience teaching 1 to 1 or in small groups.
9. Fluency in English (speaks, read and write).
10. Fluency in Spanish (speaks, translate, read and write).
