Under the direction of the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) and Chief Medical Officer (CMO), the Director of Quality, Health Equity and Innovation. (DQHEI) is responsible for the implementation and evaluation of Population Health and Quality Improvement at NEVHC. The DQHEI is also responsible for planning, organizing, implementing and evaluating public health programs including immunization services, chronic disease programs, and health education/equity programs as per established goals and objectives. The Program Director maintains regular communication with program collaborators, external regulatory agencies pertaining to programs and internal stakeholders within NEVHC. This position is also responsible for development of the strategic plan and annual operating plan, and works collaboratively to apply innovative techniques to solve challenging programs and improve the quality and efficiency of patient care at NEVHC. The Director is a member of the Executive Staff supporting practice transformation and population management.

Qualifications:

1. Registered Nurse (RN) preferred. Bachelor's degree required (Bachelor's degree in Nursing, Public Health, Health Administration preferred). Master's degree required (MPH preferred), Commission for Health Education Credentialing (CHES) certification desirable.
2. At least three (3) years administrative experience in a community-based health or social service program working with low income, uninsured or disparate populations.
3. Knowledge and experience in curricula development required. Knowledge of principles of adult learning, motivational interviewing and other health education strategies. Previous teaching experience in a health care setting is highly desirable.
4. Excellent leadership skills.
5. Math skills sufficient to prepare routine spreadsheets, calculate/balance invoices/expense reports, and similar.
6. Demonstrated supervisory skills sufficient to supervise from 5 to 7 employees.
7. Demonstrated managerial skills sufficient to manage from 5 to 7 employees through other supervisors and/or managers.
8. Very effective oral and written communications skills including public speaking experience.
9. Ability to work effectively as a team player.
10. Fluency in English (speak, read and write).
11. Fluency in Spanish (speak, translate, read and write) is preferred.
12. Current California driver's license, appropriate insurance coverage and a driving record acceptable to the NEVHC's insurance carrier (if required to drive on the job).
