Forms Sent To Your Patients (English & Spanish Included):

- **PA 4045**: Informs Current Beneficiaries that they will need to provide proof of US citizenship and identity at their annual redetermination (English & Spanish)
- **PA 4046:** Informs New Applicants that they will need to provide proof of US citizenship and identity at their annual redetermination (English & Spanish)
- DHCS 0001: Lists exemptions from DRA requirements and documents to bring (<u>English</u> & <u>Spanish</u>)
- **DHCS 0003**: Affidavit of Reasonable Effort to get Proof of Citizenship (English & Spanish)
- DHCS 0005: Receipt of Citizenship and/or Identity Documents (English & Spanish)

Copies of all DHCS forms are available online in <u>Arabic</u>, <u>Armenian</u>, <u>Chinese</u>, <u>Farsi</u>, <u>Hmong</u>, <u>Khmer</u>, <u>Korean</u>, <u>Laotian</u>, <u>Russian</u>, <u>Spanish</u>, <u>Tagalog</u> and <u>Vietnamese</u>.
