PROPEL'S APPRENTICESHIP MODEL

YOUNG PEOPLE NEED OPTIONS & EMPLOYERS NEED TALENT

WORK



Apprentices are **paid employees working on the floor from day 1** to cover center responsibilities while they develop their skills.

LEARN



Apprentices complete **medical assistant certification coursework** through Loyola Marymount University.

DEVELOP



On-the-job mentors support apprentices' progress.

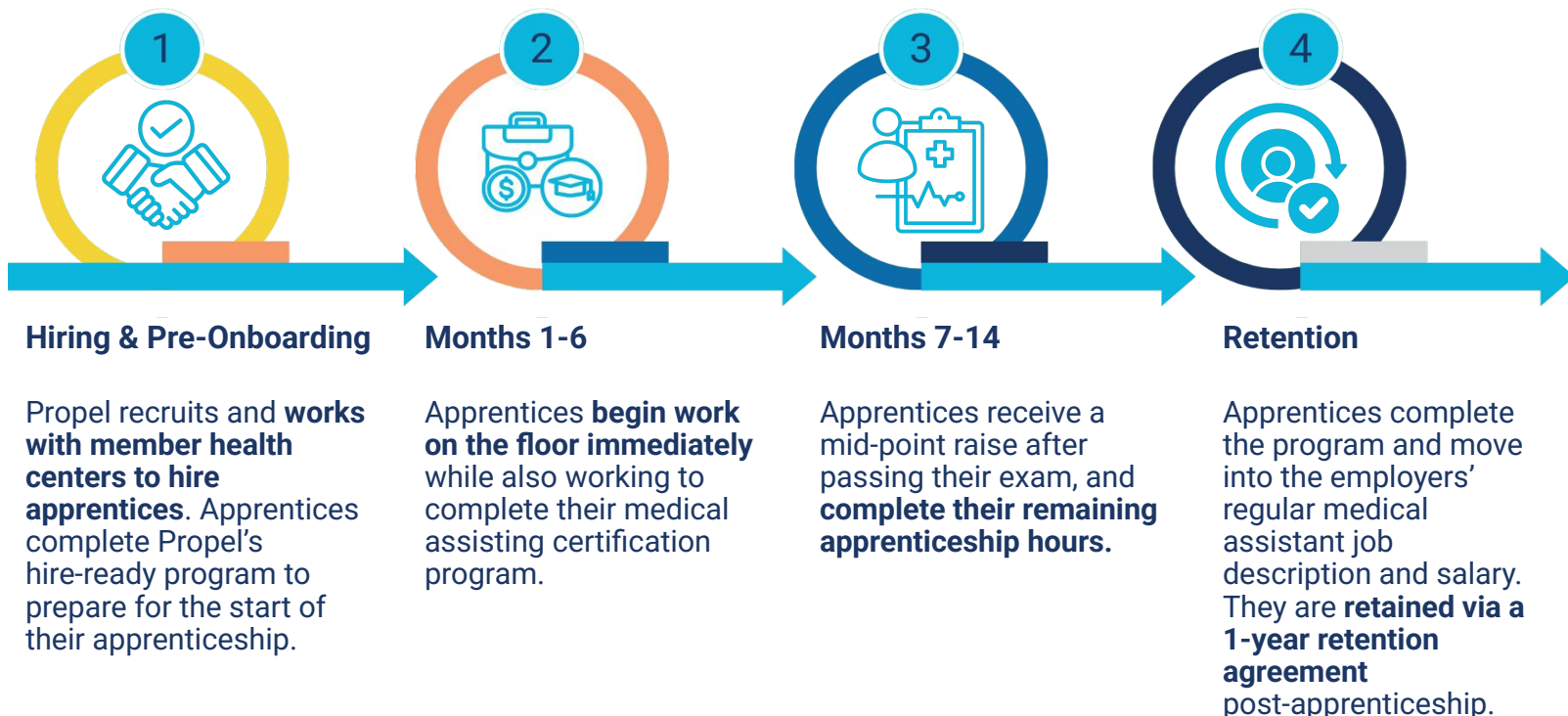
Propel's team provides **additional supportive services.**

GROW



Apprentices earn a **starting wage that increases after passing their certification exam** and moving to a certified medical assistant role.

HOW IT WORKS

APPRENTICESHIP FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES (ONCE REGISTERED)

WIOA

Ongoing funding

50% wage rate reimbursement, not to exceed 6 months/ \$10,000

CA Opportunity Youth Grant

Ongoing grant

Up to \$10,000 per apprentice, a portion of which goes to employer

CA Apprenticeship Innovation Fund

Reimbursement grant

\$3-4k per apprentice, a portion of which goes to employer

Workforce Board

Ongoing grant

\$950 to employer

Propel funds tuition costs through a combination of contributions from public funding and philanthropy
