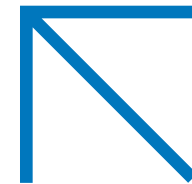

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Local, state and federal funding, reimbursement and regulatory structures, and policies that ensure the long-term stability and sustainability of Medi-Cal.

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Fair reimbursement rates for all patients.

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Protecting the purpose and intent of Proposition 35; efforts to maintain California's MCO tax and maximize MCO tax resources for health centers.

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Fair FQHC participation, and accommodation of the FQHC reimbursement structure, in Medi-Cal services, programs, and initiatives.

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Policies that advance the successful participation and integration of health centers in care transformation and managed care programs and initiatives.
